In addition to teaching content, our teachers attend to the formation of good habits in our students.

A successful elementary candidate will have the following prerequisite skills, credentials, and expertise:

- Experience teaching elementary students, preferably in a classical school.
- Knowledge of the methods and goals of classical education.
- Knowledge of Spalding Phonics (preferred).
- Knowledge with Singapore Math (preferred).
- Desire to teach character in addition to content, with an emphasis on our lower school habits of attention, obedience, respect, and responsibility.
- Excellent classroom management skills.

Familiarity with Charlotte Mason’s approach to habit formation is preferred but not required.
